



ROOF MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST

Exterior Inspection

A seasonal roof tune-up can prevent minor issues can quickly turn into costly emergencies in winter. Here is a checklist for common areas on your roof to inspect and maintain to ensure your roof is in great shape.

	Check for missing, cracked, or curled shingles and replace them as needed.
	Look for loose or damaged flashing around chimneys, vents, and skylights to prevent leaks.
	Inspect roof valleys for wear, as these areas are especially prone to damage.
	Examine seals and caulking around roof penetrations (pipes, vents) for cracks or gaps.
A	ttic and Interior Check
	Inspect the attic for any signs of leaks, such as water stains, mold, or mildew.
	Look for light peeking through the roof boards, which can indicate gaps or potential leaks.
	Check for proper attic ventilation to prevent moisture buildup, which can cause rot and ice dams
	in winter.
Seal and Secure	
	Apply sealant or caulking to any cracks or seams that could allow water to penetrate.
	Re-caulk roof pentrations such as plumbing vents, exhaust pipes, and HVAC stacks.
	Remove or replace high nails.
G	utters and Drainage
	Clear out leaves and debris from gutters and downspouts to ensure proper drainage.
	Ensure gutters are securely attached to the roof and house to prevent water buildup and overflow.
	Make sure downspouts are properly extended away from the foundation to avoid water damage.
C	lean and Treat Roof Surface
	Clear off moss, algae, or mold growth, which can hold moisture and damage shingles over time.
	Use an appropriate roof cleaner and soft brush to remove buildup without damaging shingles.
	Treat the roof with a protective coating if needed to add extra water and UV protection.
